Arrangement of Occupational Health

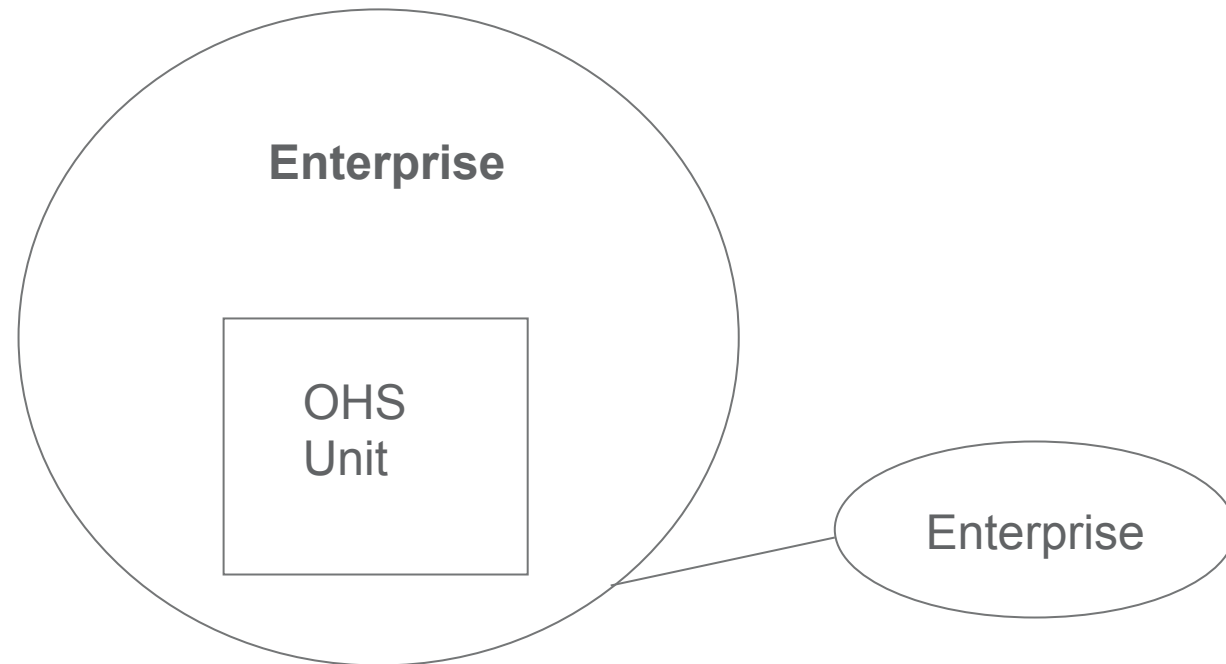

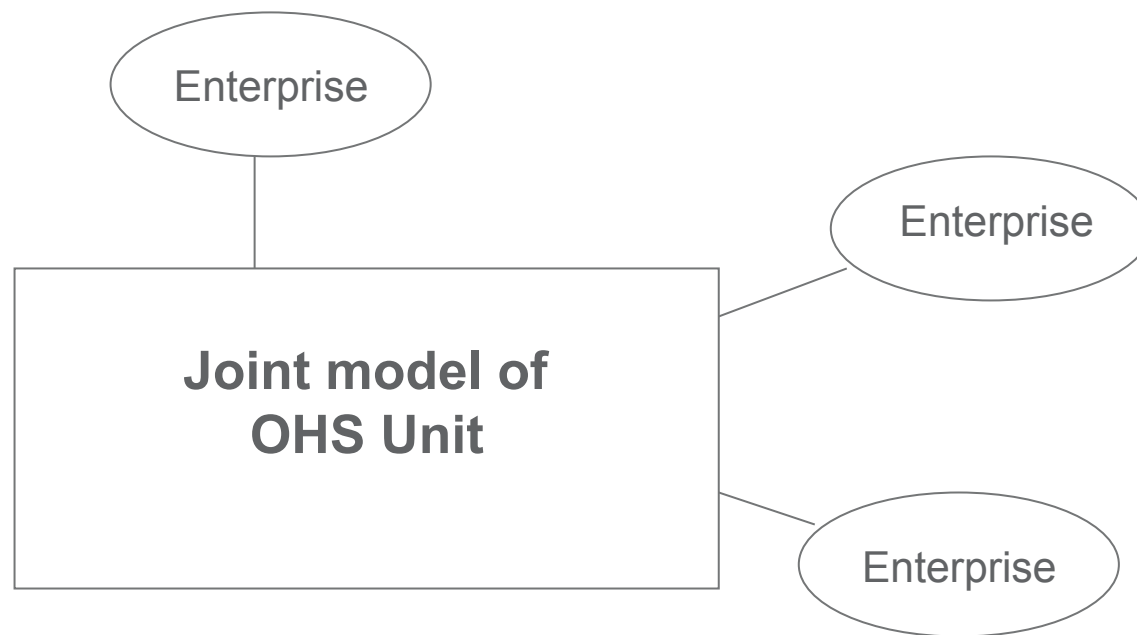

Enterprises own OHS Devices



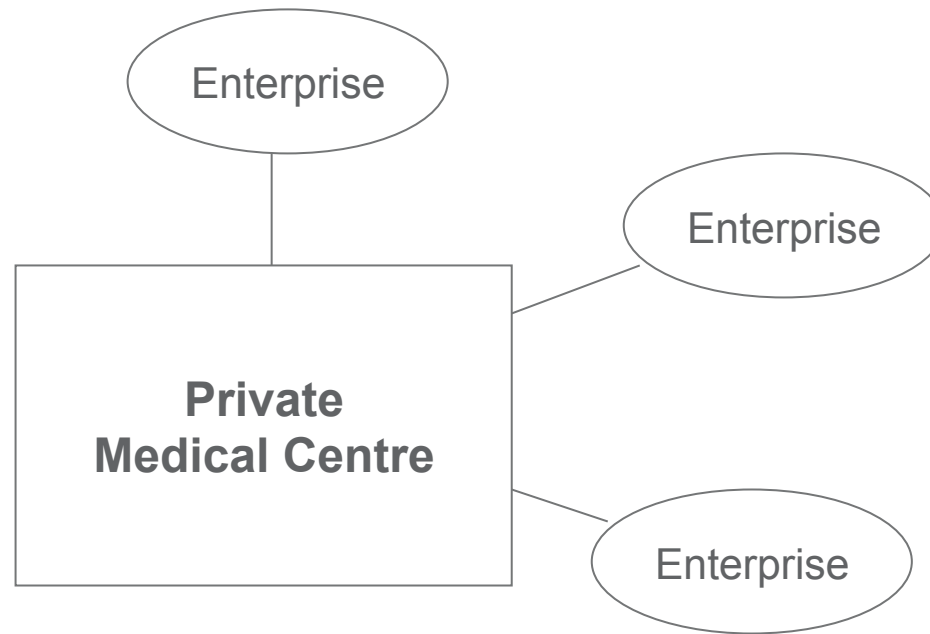

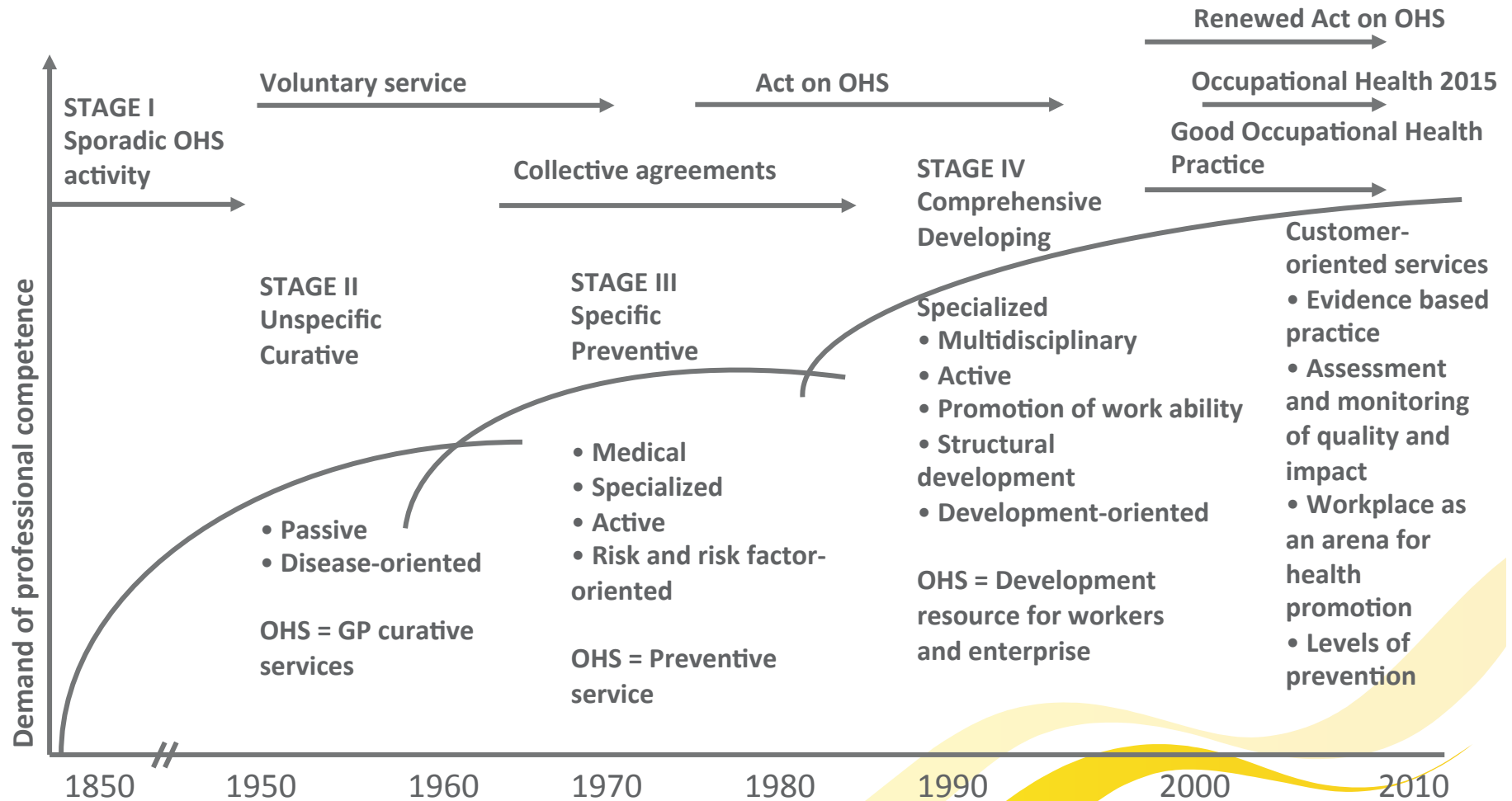
Medical Centres
